Seven primary subject areas will address the dominant theme which includes movement stability in lumbopelvic pain, pelvic girdle pain (diagnostics, risk factors and motor control), cognitive aspects of treatment, evidence based practice for low back pain along with diagnosis and treatment, connective tissue and the role of fascia, surgical management and sports medicine and exercise.

Weekend workshops will share clinician experience in the management of lumbopelvic pain. Open poster presentation will illustrate the worldwide research of new and innovative ideas in the field.
