



INSTRUCTIONS TO POSTER AND PLATFORM PRESENTERS

Poster Presenters

1. Please check in at the AAOMPT Conference Registration desk on Friday October 28th, prior to going into the Exhibit Hall to set your poster(s).
2. Please **display your poster(s) on the Poster board(s) in the Exhibit Hall on Friday October 28th, between 2:00 pm and 4:30 pm.**
3. All Poster boards will be numbered. Please place your poster on display on the appropriate poster board.
4. Pins to secure your poster will be available on the poster boards.
5. Posters will be up for viewing until the Exhibit Hall closes at 3:00 pm on Saturday.
6. Please, **remove your poster(s) between 3:00 pm and 4:00 pm on Saturday, October 29th.**
7. Please follow Posters **formatting guidelines** on display on the AAOMPT website.
8. **Judging criteria** for the poster competition are on the AAOMPT website. Review these.
9. **Poster presenters have to be present at your respective poster(s) at all time on Friday October 28th, 5:30 – 7:30 pm.**
10. Upon arrival of a judge, you will have **6 minutes to present your poster**, followed by questions.
11. Dress: wear appropriate clothing as presenter (no jeans, shorts).

Platform Presenters

1. Platform presentation competition will take place on the Research Day, on Sunday, October 30, 2010 - 8:00 am – 11:30 am.
2. **All platform presentations power point presentations will need to be on the desktop of the computer at the conference to allow smooth transitions between the presenters.** No presenter will be allowed to use their laptop or thumbdrive, as this would result in unnecessary increased time between the presenters.
3. **Meet with the Chair of the Research Committee, Jean-Michel Brismée, around lunch on Saturday October 29th or after the business meeting on Saturday evening after 7:30 pm to provide your final platform presentation on a CD-ROM or thumbdrive.**
4. If you present some **pictures and videos embedded in your presentation, we will need to make sure your links are re-set and the videos display properly** on the screen at the conference. We will check that out on Saturday evening.
5. **Judging criteria** for the platform presentations are available on the AAOMPT website, as you will be competing for the Dick Erhard best Platform Presentation award.
6. All presenters will be **allowed 8 minutes to present followed by 2 minutes of questions-answers.**
7. Dress: wear appropriate clothing as presenter (no jeans, shorts).
